Carole Hartman gave the update on the Pendleton County Chamber of Commerce and Convention and Visitors Bureau for Laura Brown, Director who was unable to attend. The Seneca Rocks Visitor Center indicated that they have had about 10,000 more visitors as of July this year over last year.

The Commission discussed with Diana Mitchell, 911 Director, the job descriptions she presented at a previous meeting. There were several changes recommended.

Diana informed the Commission that Atlas Geographic had uploaded our data to the state GIS. Gene McConnell was contacted by Mike Harmon who is head of the GIS at Northern Virginia Community College. He offered to meet with Diana and the Commissioners to discuss the mapping system. A meeting will be scheduled after October 1, 2019.

Diana stated that she hopes to meet with three applicants this week. She would like to hire one full-time dispatcher and two part-time dispatchers. Discussion was had about possibly advertising again in other counties and/or on social media.

Air Care was contacted by Diana and they referred her to Jim Miller. She has not heard back from him yet. She also contacted HealthNet in Charleston. Jeff White can meet with the Commissioners on October 1 to discuss the helipad. Gene would like Richard Nelson to attend that meeting also.

The wind sock at the Pendleton County Community Building needs to be replaced. Bruce Minor will be contacted to see about replacing it.

Diana also mentioned some new training that has been done with the rescue squads and the schools, called Stop the Bleed. She recommended that the Courthouse employees be given this training and to install a kit in the Courthouse. The Commission requested that Diana coordinate with Karen Pitsenbarger to set up the training. Carole Hartman mentioned that there should be Active Shooter training also. Karen indicated that she has already discussed this with our insurance company and they are working on setting it up.

The Sheriff's monthly financial statement for July 2019 was reviewed and filed.
