Minutes of the June 21, 2023 meeting of the County Commission, on motion of Commissioner Dahmer, were unanimously approved.

Discussion on the new handicap ramp being built and if it is wide enough. Commissioners will look at after the meeting.

Rick Gillespie, Emergency Services Coordinator, informed Commission that the new 911 admin phone system has been installed.

He mentioned that there was discussion at a quarterly meeting with the Forest Service regarding tourists blocking access to the North Fork Tower Road. They will be looking into some possible solutions.

Laura Brown, EDA Director, had no updates for broadband. Mr. Gillespie stated that the new broadband federal monies that were allocated to West Virginia most likely will require financial matches from the counties.

Karen Pitsenbarger, County Administrator, stated she has been continuing to get estimates for the removal of the old tank and placement of the new tank with little success.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dahmer, vote was unanimous, to approve a Coal Severance Fund budget revision for fiscal year 2024 to appropriate the assigned fund balance ending June 30, 2023 in the amount of \$9,562 showing an increase of \$1,562 over the original budgeted amount.

On motion of Commissioner Bennett, vote unanimous, the Commission approved a Resolution designating 50% of the Hotel/Motel Tax collected to the Pendleton County Emergency Rescue (PCER) and Pendleton County Firemen's Association (PCFA).

The Commission reviewed the fiscal year 2024 General County Budget carryover.

are incurring sufficient added expenses

Whereas the Pendleton County Commission does intend to transfer 50% of the

hotel/motel tax to PCER and PCFA to aid in offsetting added expenses.
