COMMISSIONERS PRESENT: CARL HEVENER, ROGER DAHMER AND JIMMIE BENNETT

Commissioner Dahmer led those present in prayer. Commissioner Hevener called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the April 16, 2024 meeting of the County Commission, on motion of Commissioner Dahmer, were unanimously approved.

Maintenance:

The remainder of the parking lot at Pendleton County Community Building (PCCB) has been paved and striped. They also striped at the Health Department and Courthouse. On motion of Commissioner Dahmer, vote unanimous, GW Hiner will clean the gutters at the Clinton Hedrick Community Building (CHCB).

Diana Mitchell, 911 Director, stated that nothing major was going on at the 911 Center, just normal operations.

Rick Gillespie, Emergency Services Coordinator, informed the Commission that the 911 Advisory Council is in the process of updating their by-laws.

The financial feasibility report needed to move forward with the Annex is still not completed. Once it is completed, should be able to put out for bid.

One quote for replacing the front and side doors of the Courthouse was received in the amount of \$31,792.00. All Commissioners felt that was excessive. Alternatives were discussed to allow the single point entry to move forward.

Commissioner Dahmer read a proclamation for Men's Health Week. On motion of Commissioner Dahmer, vote unanimous, the Commission proclaimed June 10 - 16, 2024 as Men's Health Week.

Mike Alt and Tina Eye submitted the first quarterly invoice for the EMS Salary Enhancement funds in the amount of \$20,960.25. They may need to revise how to reimburse volunteers as this amount is approximately \$10,000 below the amount needed to spend quarterly to expend all funds in the time period the state requires.

They also submitted an invoice in the amount of \$749.47 for the Crisis Response Team training.

Commissioner Carl Hevener was reappointed to the Region 8 Solid Waste Authority Board on motion of Commissioner Dahmer, vote unanimous.

On motion of Commissioner Dahmer, vote unanimous, the third budget revision for General County for the current fiscal year, was approved in the amount of \$167,418.00.
