Commissioner Hevener called the public meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The proposed amended enhanced 911 ordinance for Pendleton County to amend the fees as follows:

- i. Each business line shall be charged \$8.00 per month, including Business Voice Over Internet Protocol (VoIP) lines;**
- ii. Each Centrex line shall be charged \$8.00 per month;**
- iii. Each PBX line shall be charged \$8.00 per month; and**
- iv. Each residential line shall be charged \$5.00 per month, or equivalent, including Voice Over Internet Protocol (VoIP) lines. Tel-Assistance Lines are exempt.**

There being no objections or comments, on motion of Commissioner Dahmer, seconded by Commissioner Bennett, vote unanimous, the amended ordinance was approved.
